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## Why fleet safety training matters for your business

An average of 41% of work-related injury fatalities involve a vehicle collision.\*

The most significant contributor to work-related traumatic injury include:

- Unsafe drivers/vehicles
- Insufficient journey planning
- Unauthorised drivers
- Vehicles lacking adequate protection
- Inadequate post-incident response

Under the Work Health & Safety (WHS) Act 2012, a workplace is a place where work is carried out for a business or undertaking and includes any place where a worker goes, or is likely to be, while at work. The act describes a vehicle as a part of the “workplace”.

As an employer, ensuring your employees are trained to drive safely helps you achieve your WHS obligations.

## Fleet Driver Training

## Online Safe Driver Training
